

Dear Parents and Guardians of SOTA Seniors:

Congratulations... your child is a senior and projected to graduate in 2010! Your student has the unique opportunity to create their own senior page for the yearbook. Senior pages take the place of individual student photos. Their page may include photos from past years, current photos, baby pictures, their name, their major, and a meaningful quote, if desired. **There is no cost for a senior page.**

COMPLETED SENIOR PAGES ARE DUE TO MS. RUDY in M330 BY NOVEMBER 14, 2009. This is a firm deadline that we must adhere to in order to meet the yearbook production and printing schedules.

So, if you are having professional senior photos taken, it is important that they be completed and purchased early enough so that they may be included when creating your senior page. Please Note: **We can only include purchased photos, not photographer proofs.**

Senior pages must be submitted by **November 14, 2009**. Seniors may create their own pages and hand in completed pages by November 14. If a senior needs help putting together their page, they should see Ms. Rudy no later than **October 15, 2009** with their group and all of their photos and information.

The students may select who is on their page with them and create the page as a group. A minimum of **three** seniors may be on a full page (7.5" x 10.5"). If there are only two seniors, they should create a ½ page (7.5 x 5"). A senior may choose to submit an individual page, in which case it should be ¼ page (3.5 x 5").

Seniors may create their page on the computer or create a traditional collage by cutting and pasting photos on paper. The final pages are due in either paper format or on a CD. **If submitting a CD, please submit it in PDF format only.**

A letter and order form will be mailed home soon that outlines all of the important information regarding the 2010 Yearbook and other exciting senior offerings.
